POOL

Nakoma Golf Club features a eight-lane, 25-yard lap pool, complete with an attached diving well and separate kids' pool. The pool area also includes a concession stand. Swimming members can take advantage of complimentary Red Cross certified swimming lessons for their children. Our swim team, the Nakoma Orange Heads, competes against other pools and in the All-City swim meet during the summer. Family-friendly pool events are also hosted.



TENNIS

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

FULL PLAY MEMBERSHIP

Member 40 - 64 years old, includes spouse and children under the age of 23 with unlimited use of the clubhouse, golf course, pool and tennis courts.

SENIOR FULL PLAY MEMBERSHIP

Member 65 years of age or more includes spouse. Unlimited use of the clubhouse, golf course, pool and tennis courts.

INTERMEDIATE FULL PLAY 30 - 39 MEMBERSHIP

Member 30 - 39 years old, spouse and children under the age of 23; use of full facilities.

JUNIOR FULL PLAY 29 AND UNDER MEMBERSHIP

Member 23 - 29 years old, spouse and children; use of full facilities.

NON-RESIDENT FULL PLAY MEMBERSHIP

Includes spouse and children under the age of 23, who may not have a permanent address within 100 miles of the Club, and cannot be physically within that radius for more than 30 consecutive days during any calendar year. Full use of clubhouse, pool and tennis courts with a maximum of 15 rounds of golf per individual, with no more than six rounds in any given month. Maximum of 20 rounds per family. Eligible for club events.

SOCIAL, POOL AND TENNIS MEMBERSHIP

Member, spouse and children under the age of 23 with unlimited use of the clubhouse, pool and tennis courts. Includes five rounds of golf, which can be used with guests.

SOCIAL POOL MEMBERSHIP

Member, spouse and children under the age of 23, use of clubhouse and pool. Includes four rounds of golf per family per year.

SOCIAL TENNIS MEMBERSHIP

Member, spouse and children under the age of 23, use of clubhouse and tennis courts. Includes four rounds of golf per family per year.

SOCIAL CLUBHOUSE MEMBERSHIP

Member, spouse and children under the age of 23, use of clubhouse. Includes three rounds of golf per family per year.

SOCIAL SENIOR MEMBERSHIP

Member age 65 and over, includes spouse. Use of clubhouse and three rounds of golf per family per year.

NON-RESIDENT SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP

Member, spouse and children under the age of 23, who may not have a permanent address within 50 miles of the Club. Includes use of the clubhouse.

MEMBERSHIP CHARGES & FEES

***INITIATION FEE: \$1,000 - \$12,000**

Gain privilege to join the Nakoma Community

NAKOMA FOUNDATION: \$35

Helps fund scholarships for Nakoma Staff

***MEMBER DEPOSIT: \$600 - \$1,600**

Refundable after resignation (if House Account is in good standing)

MODERNIZATION: \$600 - \$1,500

Funds capital improvements of the grounds and Clubhouse

***CAPITAL STOCK: \$300 - \$1,000**

All active members (age 30+) are required to own stock based on their current membership category. Members in the "95" or "110" are not required to own stock, but relinquish voting rights if they sell their shares. Stock par value is \$100 per share and one member vote per share owned. No dividends are dispersed. Stock transfers can be performed with a \$25 per share fee, payable by the receiving member.

****EVANS SCHOLARSHIP: \$35**

Supports the Evans Scholarship Foundation.

****MILL RIVER: \$175**

Entitles members (and those covered under the membership) the ability to purchase at 10-15% over cost in the Golf Pro Shop.

MEMBER DUES:

Membership is on a calendar year basis, automatically renewed, unless otherwise formally requested (according to playbook & bylaws). Member age on January 1st dictates membership category eligibility. Should a member be married, the elder spouse's age shall be used to determine membership category eligibility.

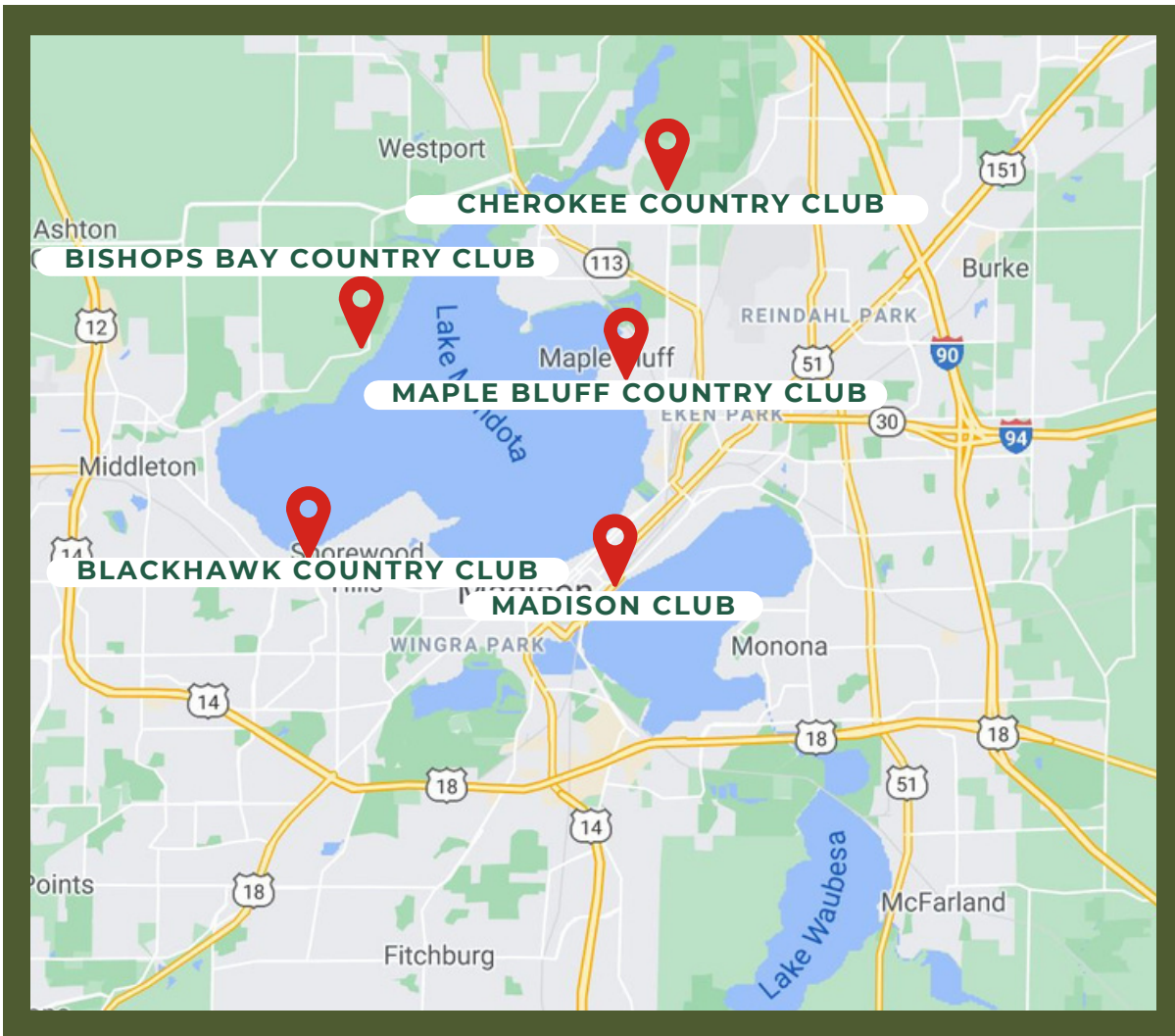

GOOD TO KNOW



DRESS CODE

Golf attire includes collared golf shirts, turtlenecks, mock turtlenecks, sweaters, jackets, slacks, skirts, walking or Bermuda shorts of an appropriate and tasteful length, and appropriate golf footwear. Women's golf clothing may follow current LPGA styles. Appropriate footwear is required at all times. No penetrating spikes are permitted. The clubhouse dress code follows that of the golf course. Hats are not permitted in the clubhouse, except in the Terrace and the Master's bar. The Nakoma Dining Room, the golf course, the practice facilities, and the tennis courts are the only areas where denim is not permitted.

The pool complex requires appropriate swimming attire and is in keeping with the family atmosphere. Footwear and cover-ups must be worn outside of the pool complex. Proper tennis attire on the tennis courts and courts and is permitted anywhere on the property with the exception of the golf course, practice range, or putting green.

NAKOMA FOUNDATION



The Nakoma Foundation is one of the things that makes us different from other traditional clubs. Nakoma Foundation is a scholarship program that benefits our employees, caddies, and children of employees educational future. When the recipient enrolls in college, the Foundation will issue checks to the appropriate college or university bursar's office. Upon high-school graduation, the recipient must begin using his/her account within one year or the funds will be returned to the program. Nakoma caddies who reach 25 "loops" each season will automatically receive compensation per loop (retroactively and moving forward) which will be set aside in their college education fund. This account can be built over the course of a student's high school career. In 2023, 31 of our employees (or their children) received \$30,680 towards their educational pursuits.

NAKOMA WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION



The Nakoma Women's Organization (NWO) promotes fellowship and fun among the ladies of NGC. It is covered by a small board of officers, chairs, and liaisons. Their responsibilities include planning events, managing the sports leagues, and interacting with various parts of the club on behalf of NWO. Every woman at Nakoma Golf Club is automatically a member of NWO.

CADDIE PROGRAM



Caddy Program: Nakoma Golf Club is one of the best caddy programs in the Madison area, with 800-1000 caddy rounds annually and a full caddy program during the summer. To help you better enjoy your next round of golf, the golf shop has put together a group of over 30 boys and girls aged 13 and older as well as some UW-Madison Evans Scholars. Nakoma caddies can assist members with their next round. Caddying is an opportunity for young boys and girls to earn money while participating in golf.
